**RE: Compliance with REACH (Regulation for Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemicals)**

To Whom It May Concern:

Snaptron Inc. provides customers with tactile dome switch products manufactured from 300 series stainless steel, which may or may not be placed on an adhesive polyester carrier material. After review of the REACH Directive and various guidance documents, Snaptron has determined that its products are classified as Articles. REACH, 3(3) defines an Article as:

*“An object which during production is given a special shape, surface or design which determines its function to a greater degree than does its chemical composition.”*

None of the chemical substances on the December 2015 and earlier candidate SVHC lists are intentionally used or added by Snaptron or our suppliers during the manufacturing process; therefore Snaptron is not subject to the registration requirements of the REACH Directive.

In preparing this response, Snaptron has relied on information provided by its suppliers.
