RE: Compliance with REACH (Regulation for Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemicals) EC 1907/2006

To Whom It May Concern:

Snaptron Inc. provides customers with tactile dome switch products manufactured from 300 series stainless steel, which may or may not be placed on an adhesive polyester carrier material. After review of the REACH Directive and various guidance documents, Snaptron has determined that its products are classified as Articles. REACH, Article 3(3) defines an Article as:

“An object which during production is given a special shape, surface or design which determines its function to a greater degree than does its chemical composition.”

Snaptron’s tactile dome switch products do not contain at greater than 0.1% by weight any of the 205 Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) that are identified on the January 2020 candidate SVHC list; nor are such substances used in any manufacturing process at Snaptron. As such, Snaptron is not subject to the registration requirements of the REACH Directive.
